"Troy's magnificent haul of six coveted Golden Guitars at Tamworth on Saturday night spectacularly confirms what a huge talent he has," the Mayor said.

"Troy now has 20 Golden Guitars to his credit and we're lucky to have secured him in our Main Concert line up this year.

"Our Main Concert line up includes some of country's finest - John Williamson, Kasey Chambers and Band, Troy Cassar-Daley and Becca Cole.

"But we also have some really hot rising stars – the 2010 Toyota Starmaker winner Luke Austen from Margate, Amber Lawrence and Harmony James."

The Mayor urged those who had been considering buying tickets to get in now to catch the very last of the early bird discounts on offer until January 31.

The Main Concert promises more than eight hours of music beginning at 2pm on Saturday May 1.

Discounted early bird tickets to the concert are available until January 31 at \$54.90 for adults and \$26.90 for children aged 8 to 15.

From February 1 prices will rise to \$64.90 for adults and \$29.90 for children.
