Diana Trask returns

In a coup for Caboolture's Urban Country Music Festival, the legendary Diana Trask is returning from the US to launch her autobiography and perform some of her greatest hits.

Moreton Bay Regional Council Mayor Allan Sutherland said Diana Trask, known as Miss Country Soul, had been a huge name both in Australian music and overseas in the 1960s and 70s.

"It's fantastic that Diana has chosen Caboolture to launch her book *Whatever Happened to Diana Trask* and I am sure her many fans will be lining up to give her a warm welcome," Mayor Sutherland said.

The singer, who toured the world and performed with stars such as Frank Sinatra, Jack Benny, Sammy Davis Jnr, Jerry Lewis and George Burns, is making a special guest appearance on stage at Urban Country's Main Concert at Caboolture Showgrounds on Saturday, May 1.

"There's no place I would rather be than with my great country music fans in Queensland," Diana said.

She is known in Australia for hits like *Oh Boy*, *I Fall to Pieces*, *Lock Stock and Teardrops*, *Hold on to What You Got* and had her own television variety program *The Diana Trask Show*.

"We've secured Diana for three songs, which she'll perform late afternoon and I believe her hit *Oh Boy* will be one of the three," Mayor Sutherland said.

"I can't wait to hear her among our fantastic line up of stars that includes John Williamson, Kasey Chambers and Band, Troy Cassar-Daley and Beccy Cole.

"It's a real bonus for Urban Country fans, who have already secured their tickets to the Main Concert, but it's also an added incentive for those looking for a value for money concert involving some of the biggest names in Australian country music to buy their tickets now.

"Diana will be signing copies of her biography *Whatever Happened to Diana Trask* at the concert, only a day after its official launch in Caboolture."
