

# How to get To and Around the Urban Country Music Festival 2012



## Getting Around the Festival

### Free Shuttle Bus

- Catch the **Free Festival Shuttle Bus** to avoid parking and traffic issues at the festival
- Shuttle bus stops are conveniently located throughout Caboolture and Morayfield
- Free buses run all weekend from festival venues to:
  - PARK n RIDE locations (below)
  - CBD and shops
  - accommodation venues
  - festival camping
  - Caboolture train station

### Park n Ride

- Free car parking available at:
  - **Morayfield Shopping Centre, Morayfield Road** (take the Morayfield Road exit off the Bruce highway)
  - **Cnr Beerburrum Road and James St** (take the King Street exit off the Bruce highway)
  - **Multi storey car park, King Street** (take the King Street exit off the Bruce highway)
- Catch the free shuttle bus from these PARK n RIDE locations all weekend

### Catch a Cab

- Call the festivals preferred taxi company, Black and White Cabs on 131 800

### Walk

- All festival venues are within walking distance to each other with the furthest distance between venues being approximately 1km
- Camping sites are located next to the festival venues making getting around the festival very easy
- Dedicated pedestrian walkways are available. Please ensure you stay on these paths and do not walk on roadways at any time (we don't want you to get hurt)

### Disabled Car Parking

Parking is available for people with disabled vehicle permits at each venue. Entry details are:

- **The Village** – outside Caboolture Historical Village
- **Showgrounds** – enter via Gate 2 off Beerburrum Road during car parking times listed below (fees may apply)
- **Concerts** – to be confirmed

# Getting To the Festival

## By Train

- **Caboolture Train Station** is on the main Brisbane to Nambour line. Trains from the north or south stop at Matthew Tce, a few minutes drive from the festival venues
- Free festival shuttle buses run regularly from the station to the festival
- **Note: Patrons attending the Saturday and Sunday Night Concerts who wish to travel by train should check all train times on [www.translink.com.au](http://www.translink.com.au) as not all trains will be running after the concerts**

## By Car

**There is NO parking at the Historical Village, QSEC or surrounding streets. We recommend the PARK n RIDE service. Limited paid car parking is available at the Showgrounds (see below)**

- Take Exit 152 (Caboolture, Bribie Island, Kilcoy) off the Bruce Highway
- Continue along off ramp and take the **D'Aguliar Highway** and **Kilcoy** exit (3<sup>rd</sup> exit if travelling from south or 1<sup>st</sup> exit if travelling from north)
- Continue along **D'Aguliar Highway**
- Take the **Pumicestone Road** exit
- Turn left into **Pumicestone Road**
- Turn right at the 1<sup>st</sup> set of lights onto **Beerburrum Road**, then....

### ....If you are camping

- Go straight ahead at the next set of lights onto Old Gympie Road
- Turn right at Gate 11 for Showgrounds Camping
- **OR** Continue along road and turn right at Gate 14 for QSEC Camping

### ....If you are parking at the Showgrounds

- Follow **Beerburrum Road** and enter at **Gate 2**
- Limited Showgrounds parking available at the following times:

**Friday - 2pm to 11pm**

**Saturday - 8am to 12midnight**

**Sunday - 2pm to 12midnight**

*Note no parking during Showgrounds Sunday Markets*

**Monday - 8am to 3pm**

- Cost is \$5 per car per entry
